**DIGITAL AND ONLINE DONATIONS TO OUR LADY OF LOURDES PARISH:** This weekend sees the installation of a new electronic Donation machine at St Philip Neri and ‘QR code’ facility which will allow parishioners to make electronic donations using your credit and bank cards for all of our churches.

The intention is to have this electronic access to provide an additional way of giving to the weekly collection for the increasing number of people who don’t carry cash (these are in the main ‘younger’ people). It will work alongside our current method of collections – there is no need to change the way you currently give.

Either scan the code on your smart phone or try the machine if you are in St Philip Neri. It is installed on a corner unit next to the walkway to the hall.

The machine is very easy to use but if you have questions please raise them with your steward who should be able to answer.....

The first time a person uses their card to donate, they are asked if they wish to gift aid the amount. If you are a tax payer, we encourage this. The process takes less than 1 minute to complete.....
